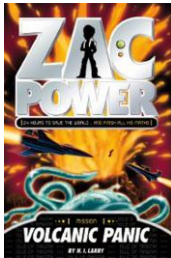




SUGGESTED READING LIST CLASS THREE - 2012

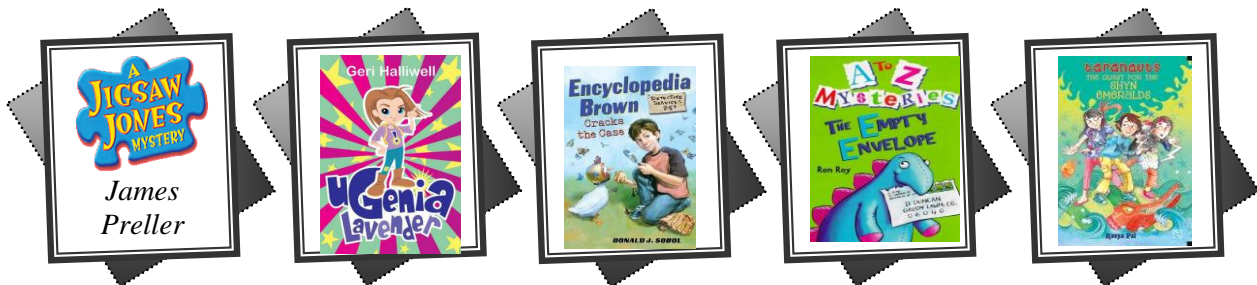
